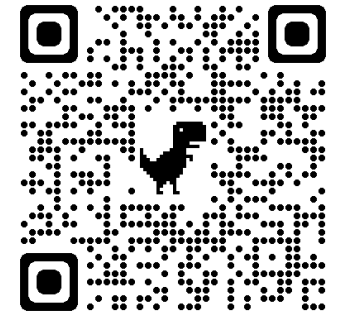
Figure 8 - Detail of Roll Plot (Segment 1)



CORE-2-COAST ALIGNMENT FEASIBILITY STUDY



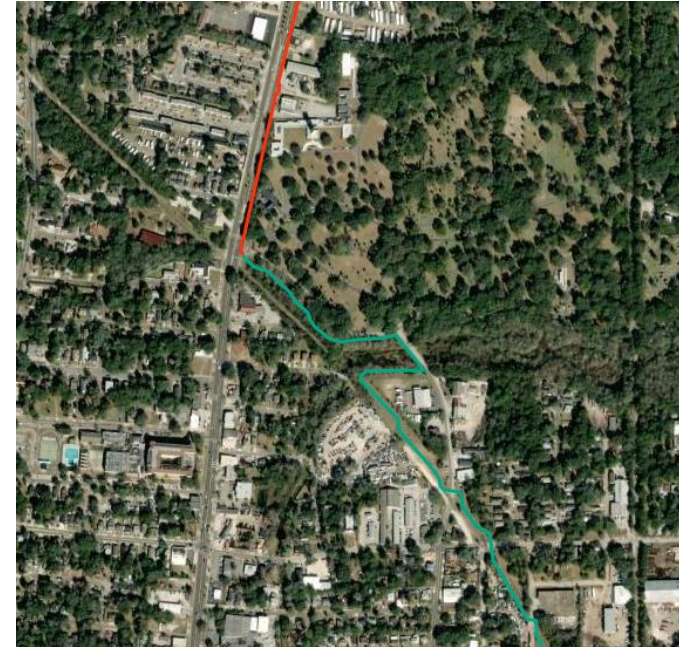
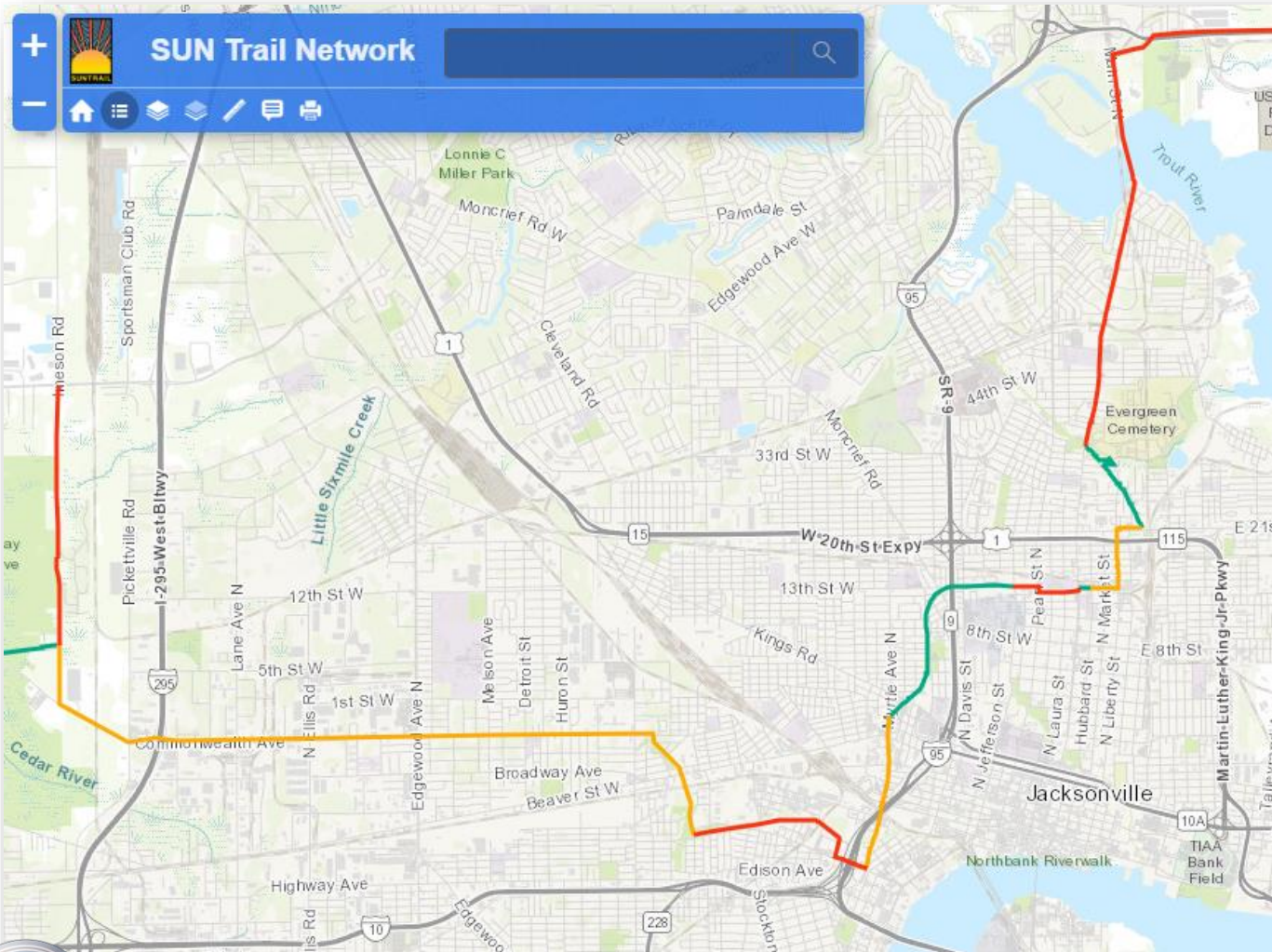
