The purpose of this report is to document our follow-up review of our past report #809, Hillwood Master Disposition & Development Agreement Audit, and to determine whether corrective action has been taken in response to our findings and recommendations. We are providing this special written report in accordance with Ordinance Code Section 102.102. This report does not represent an audit or attestation conducted pursuant to Government Auditing Standards.

We sent a follow-up letter to the Office of Economic Development on July 7, 2020 inquiring as to the status of the original audit report recommendation. We reviewed the recommendation from our audit report, the auditee's response to the recommendation, and the auditee's response to our follow-up letter. We then performed limited testing to verify the response.

Based on the response received and our follow-up testing, it appears that the responsible parties complied with our recommendation without exception. Below is a table detailing the original number of issue noted and the number of issues resolved as of this follow-up.
