WHEREAS: The United States Small Business Administration estimates that there are currently

31.7 million small businesses operating nationwide, representing 99.9 percent of all

American businesses with employees; and

WHEREAS: Small Business Saturday, observed the Saturday after Thanksgiving, highlights the

significance of supporting small, independently owned businesses across the country;

and

WHEREAS: The majority of small businesses reported that they need consumer spending to

return to pre-COVID levels by the end of 2020 in order to stay in business and said it would be most helpful to their business to have their "regulars" return to make

purchases again; and

WHEREAS: Most consumers are currently looking for ways to "Shop Small" to support their

community. In 2019, an estimated \$19.6 billion was spent at independent retailers and restaurants on Small Business Saturday and 95 percent of consumers who shopped on Small Business Saturday reported the day makes them want to shop or eat at small, independently-owned businesses all year long, not just during the

holiday season; and

WHEREAS: The City of Jacksonville recognizes Martin Coffee Company for Small Business

Saturday 2020. Martin Coffee Company, is Jacksonville's oldest independent specialty coffee roaster, has been a staple in our community since 1957, and is family-owned

and operated by the third generation of the Martin family; and

WHEREAS: By supporting our local businesses, Jacksonville residents are not only contributing

to job creation and boosting our local economy, but also helping these businesses

preserve and contribute to more vibrant communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LENNY CURRY, by virtue of the authority vested in me as mayor of
